



## **1. Intent**

The aim of our EYFS curriculum at Beardall Fields:

## **2. Implementation**

The ways in which we implement these in school is through:

- A 'Teaching for Mastery' approach which means the whole class works on the same concepts at the same time, building confidence, knowledge and skills in small, logical steps.
- Develop a love of reading across the Early Years Foundation Stage which engages the children with quality texts and new vocabulary.
- Building strong relationships with parents and carers and keeping them updating using Class Dojo and newsletters.
- Immersing the children with a topic-based curriculum which introduces key knowledge and enhanced vocabulary.
- Making sure our learning environment is language rich and promotes independent learning.
- Providing a safe environment for the children which is built upon our whole school values.
- Observing the children during their learning time and developing knowledge and skills.

## **3. Impact**

The impact of this will be:

- More children in the EYFS will achieve a Good Level of Development by the end of the year.
- Children will be confident at using No Nonsense Phonics and Power Maths books.
- Our children will become independent and ready for transition into Year 1.
- A sustained narrowing of the gap between our vulnerable groups of children and their peers.
